Brief Description

- 1) The District School Board, Howrah (the then) was established in the Year of about 1940 and thereafter in the Year of 1990, District School Board was reconstituted as District Primary School Council, Howrah under West Bengal Primary Education Act 1973.
- 2) The 1st Chairman of the District Primary School Council, Howrah was Prof. Amal Sarkar, and presently Sri Krishna Ghosh is the Chairman of the DPSC, Howrah.
- 3) There are 2059 Primary and Jr. Basic School under District Primary School Council, Howrah having with 34 Circles within 2 Sub-Division of the district. (Howrah Sadar Sub-Division & Uluberia Sub-Division)
- 4) As on July 2023, there are 8255 Teachers out of sanctioned post of 9823 and there are about more than 2.5 Lakh students under the District Primary School Council, Howrah.
- 5) The Staff and all the teachers are trying with their level best efforts for spreading Primary Education at every corner of the district.

OUR ACTIVITIES

- 1) Disbursement of Primary Teachers'-Salary and pay all kind of services with a smile to the existing teachers and retired teachers also.

- 9) Installed Solar System in many of the rural schools with the help of Howrah Zilla Parishad.
- 10) Provided Computers and accessories in many of the schools of the district.
